

On the 4th of December 2023, to coincide with the UN COP28 Climate Negotiations, the Carbon Literacy Project will be holding the biggest-ever climate education-and-action training event.

The action day offers an opportunity for as many learners as possible from all walks of life, organisations, sectors and backgrounds, to complete their Carbon Literacy training simultaneously on a single day, and pledge low carbon actions to reduce emissions. Getting involved in the Action Day is simple: all you have to do is schedule or join a course that ends before 11:59pm on Monday 4th December.
